**STREET ADMINISTER REPORT:** Clifford will be ordering signs to place near our new traffic lights as directed in order for the signals to be eligible as unmotorized. **NEW BUSINESS:** \*Maintenance needs a post driver, safety cones and lumber for signposts. Mike motioned to purchase, Clifford seconded. AIF

**PRESIDENT COMMENTS:** Shannon is working on several grants for the village and will keep us updated. \*The village needs a zoning board and Shannon will notify people in the newsletter going out soon. Blight letters will go out after spring cleanup and, if needed, tickets for any noncompliance. \*She is also working on grants for the cameras in the park, splash pad, and a farmer's market! \*Shannon has asked for bids from Elmer's and Ron Brown to pave Cedar and 5<sup>th</sup> streets. \*Shannon asked for a final vote as to whether the village should hold onto Imhoff and pay to fix it, or to deed it over to the township. Roll call vote: Shannon and Clifford -keep. Jan and Mike- give it to the township. Chris absent.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Dave Myers discussed the possibility of the township buying a land-locked parcel which is now owned by the Legion. He will research. It may be wetlands.

**MOTION TO ADJOURN:** Clifford made a motion to adjourn at, 8:23 Mike seconded. AIF, passed.
